Grant Amounts Applicable:

- Up to \$150 for regional events (within BC but greater than 100 km from home location).
- Up to \$300 for larger events (events with 100+ participants, provincial or national championships).
- Grants will be considered based on cost of entry / registration, travel costs. Amount not to exceed total entry & travel cost. (Confirmation of event participation & a copy of receipts will be required prior to payment of grant.)

Pursuit of Athletic Excellence Details

- This grant is available to KOC members who travel to participate in major orienteering & trail-running events.
- This grant is available to KOC members who travel to officiate orienteering events.
- This grant is available to KOC members who travel to orienteering training camps & trail-running camps.
- This grant is available to KOC members who travel to sport development clinics (eg: officials/coaching clinics).

Requirements for applications for the Pursuit of Athletic Excellence Grant:

- Applicants must be KOC members in good standing and have participated in or been actively involved in club
 events within the past year
- Applicants must be BC residents for the last 12 months prior to the event.
- Applicants may apply for grant up to 30 days after event.
- Funding is approved on a first come-first served basis to the limit of the annual POE budget.
- Junior applicants < 17 years will require a coach or approved chaperone.

Kootenay Orienteering Club members are eligible for one Pursuit of Excellence grant per year.
